The training will take place on a grade 2+/3+ river

Fluidskills.com can deliver this course all over the UK and the French Alps; the assessment will be over two days focusing on personal skills and leadership styles and structures on grade 2/3 white water. The course also will cover aspects of white water rescue and safety as part of a group.

A full detailed action plan during the course will assist in your personal development after your assessment course. Successful assessment at this level indicates that the paddlers can consider themselves white water leaders on grade 2/3 white water. As they can now lead on moving waters they can do this in a competent manner and have the knowledge and ability to run a trip down a grade 2/3 river.
